- 9. Perform and comply with all other mandated duties and responsibilities as per the Education Act 2009 and Education Amendment Act 2019.

- Promote the use of relevant technology to support and differentiate instruction during a lesson.

Classroom Learning

As a teacher, you will work to ensure your students are engaged in their learning.

- Develop and deliver lessons to all students in the class with concerted efforts made to recognize varying learning levels and abilities of students.
- Teach according to the educational needs, abilities and achievements of the individual students and groups of students in the class.
- Regularly assign, correct and mark work carried out by students.
- Provide consistent, immediate feedback to students on their learning and ask analytical questions that elicit students' responses that incorporate prior knowledge, life experience and interests that are directly related to the content objective
- Provide opportunities to encourage critical thinking, reasoning and problem solving skills.
- Provide or contribute to oral and written assessments, reports and references relating to individual students or groups of students in the class.
- Make use of audio-visual technological devices/aides (such as radio aids; projectors) and other adaptations during the delivery of the lessons.
- Register and regularly monitor the attendance of students under one's care.
- Assess, record and report on the development, progress, attainment and behaviour of students.
- Nurture a culture where students view themselves essentially as facilitators of their own learning.

Working as part of a team

As a teacher, you are expected to be fully committed to your school by engaging in all school activities and upholding school regulations.

- Assist to implement the School Improvement Plan and School Annual Plan.
- Participate in school based and cluster professional development programs and staff meetings.
- Advise and co-operate with the School Principal, Vice Principal, Infant Supervisor, School Librarian, and other teachers in the preparation and development of teaching materials, teaching programmes, methods of teaching and assessment and pastoral care arrangements.
- Communicate, consult and co-operate with other members of the school staff, including those having posts of special responsibility and parents/guardians to ensure the best interest of students.
- Contribute to the professional development of new teachers and student teachers according to arrangements agreed to with the School Principal.
- Participate in school assemblies.
- Ensure the safe custody and optimum use of equipment normally used by oneself during lessons and sees to its regular servicing and maintenance.
- Share in any possible and reasonable way in the effective management, organisation, order and discipline of the school.
- Ensure high standards of professional practice and quality of teaching and learning of the subject/s through effective dialogue.
