


Figure 1: Nikki Mariner, Samoan Twilight, 2019, Manamea Art Studio






Figure 2: Artist Losloanos Pinoyll, Motootua, 2019, Manamea Art




Figure 5: Fatu Feu'u, 'Ola' painting 2017
